



- Direct AVTA bus from Palmdale AVC center




SCHEDULE/ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS

- Mon/Wed block and Tues/Thur block and alternating Fridays
- High School 1st period begins 7:50 am & 5th period ends 4:30 pm
 - AVC courses can start and end outside of SOAR's bell schedule
- Students will not necessarily have classes back to back
- May have unscheduled time between classes (high school and college)
- No bells -students are expected to get to class on time (high school and college)


AVID/COMMUNITY SERVICE EXPECTATIONS




